
### **FOREWORD**

J. I. Sheffield set a local school record by scoring 150 points, which is believed to be also a conference record. However, records are not available to substantiate this.


Throughout the season the boys gave the spectators, students, and coaches many thrills with their long runs, good blocking by our lineman, and long scoring passes for important T.D.'s.

With a little more experience and a few breaks, the season would have been more impressive from the record standpoint. Nevertheless, we were pleased with a job well done.


J. I. Sheffield, Thomas Clark, and Pat Parker will be the three Seniors lost by the team this year. J. I., who played 4
