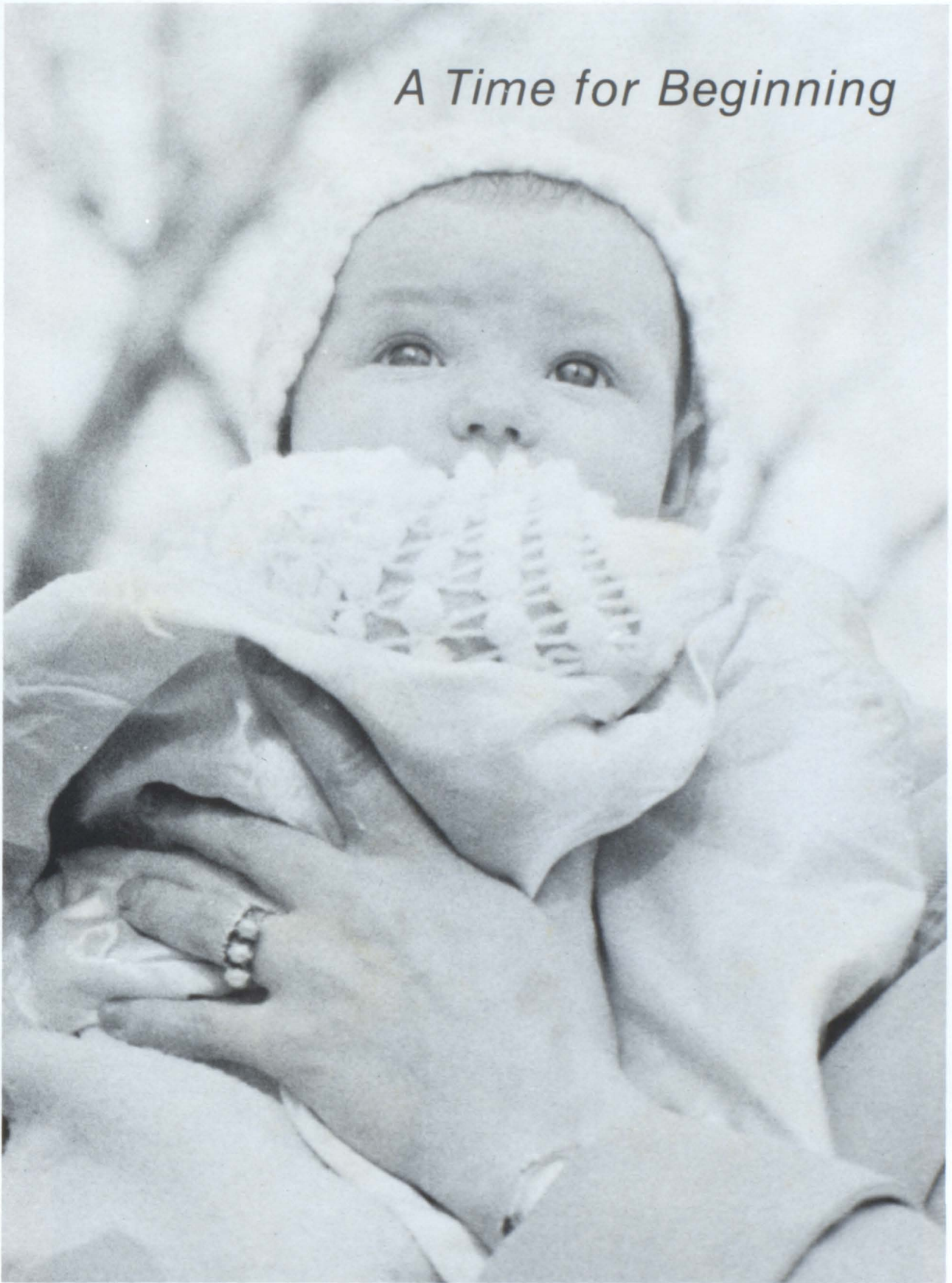
Dedication—Time Passing
